

School Direct Initial Teacher Training Programme

School Direct routes into teaching are school based programmes of initial teacher training. The course is based in school, training in the day to day environment of teaching, alongside University allocated days and designated school based training sessions that support the programme.

School Direct routes into teaching leads to the award of Postgraduate Certificate in Education (PGCE) with Qualified Teacher Status (QTS) at Primary level. Applications to postgraduate teacher training routes are through UCAS Teacher Training Portal. To register and apply contact [UCAS Teacher Training portal](#). UCAS manages applications to all postgraduate teacher training routes. Partnership schools can be contacted to check that they still have availability and University requirements and programmes should always be checked to ensure they suit your needs.
