

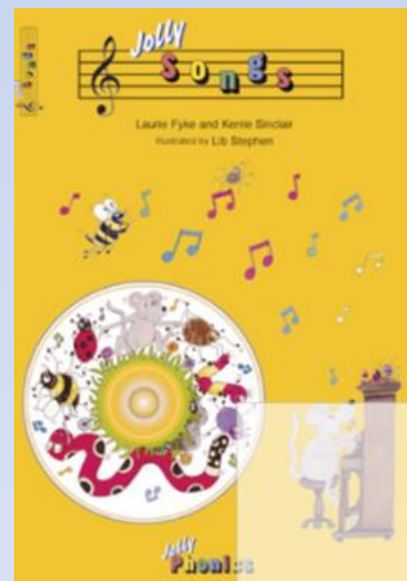

Phonics

- Daily phonics lessons – taught in ability groups across Reception plus daily Literacy lessons.
- We have a well developed phonics programme and often supplement this with Jolly Phonics songs.
- Children will learn initial sounds, then learn to blend them together to form words and then sentences.
- Sounds are articulated differently to how you may remember from school – Oxford owls on school website will support key sounding.

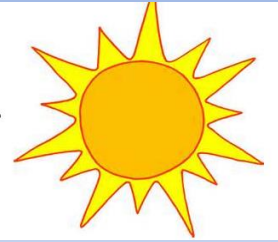

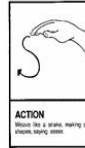

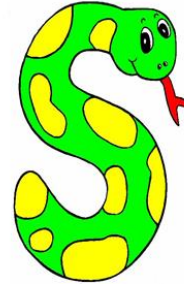

Phonics – At home

- Phonic book – Termly linked directly to sounds being learnt in school.
- Home/school tasks (purple book) will share the sounds that are being learnt in class.
- The books share sounds, pictures, words that support articulating the sounds and seeing them in words that can be identified and read.
- There are opportunities to practise writing the sound.
- Common exception words that we practise reading by sight.
- Nonsense words

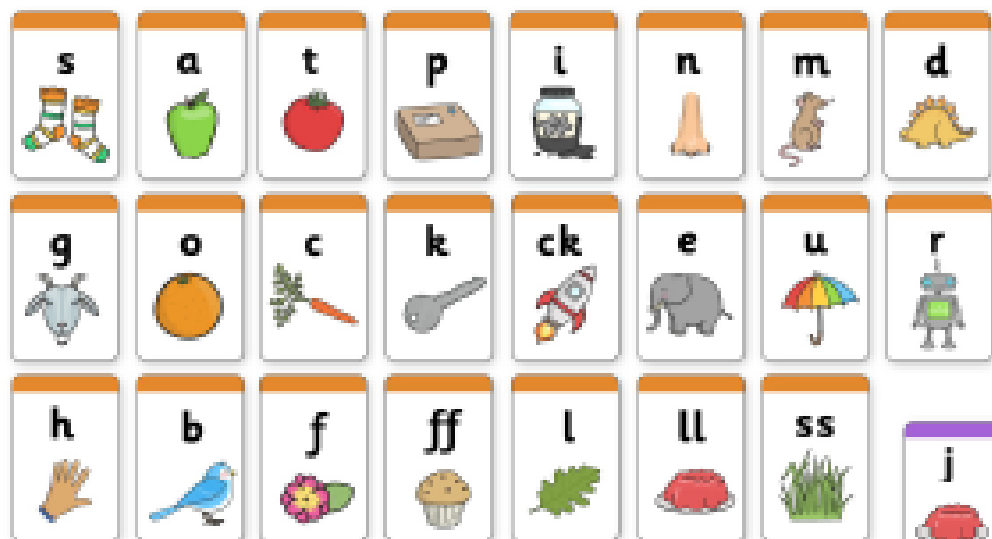
