

Year 4 Residential to Conwy Monday 19th May – Wednesday 21st May


<u>Accommodation – Conwy Youth</u> Hostel

Sleeping:

- Bedrooms accommodate groups of 2, 3 or 4 children
- Bedroom groups sorted before
- All bedrooms have ensuite

- Elston Hall staff are spread out across the two floors of the building to ensure every child has at least one staff member close.
