Accommodation – Conwy Youth Hostel

Sleeping:

- Bedrooms accommodate groups of 2, 3 or 4 children

- Elston Hall staff are spread out across the two floors of the building to ensure every child has at least one staff member close.

- Food is eaten in the dining hall, a system similar to school.
