What will we be learning in Art?

- To show awareness of the potential of the uses of materials

- To use different techniques, colours and textures when designing and making pieces of work
- To use stitching techniques to combine fabrics

What will we be doing in Art?

- We will look at a variety of materials and recognise their properties eg, hardwearing, flimsy etc
- We will learn that some fabrics can fray, and they will need to secure the edges, so this does not happen
- We will practice different stitch types
- We will look at photographs of poppies for inspiration for our own work
- We will sketch our own poppy imageries
- We will use our sewing skills to attach material together to make a poppy

Words you will be using:

fabrics

cloth or other material produced by weaving or knitting fibres



thread

a long, thin strand of cotton, nylon, or other fibres used in sewing or weaving



stitching

the activity of sewing individual thread in something



installation

a work of art that usually consists of multiple components often in mixed media and that is exhibited in a usually large space in an arrangement specified by the artist
