What is a prefix?

A Prefix

A prefix is added to the beginning of a word to make a new word.

Most prefixes are added to the beginning of root words without changing the spelling - for example:

```
Super + man = Superman
Auto + graph = Autograph
Anti + social = Antisocial.
```

What does the prefix Super mean?

supernatural	Greater than normal natural powers.	
superhero	Cartoon character that has extraordinary powers.	
supernova	A star that suddenly increases greatly in brightness because of a catastrophic explosion.

What does the prefix Auto mean?

A device or process that works by itself with little or no direct human control.

A device or process that works by itself with little or no direct human control.

Written by the author themselves.

History of a person which is written by that person her/himself.

The prefix auto means self or own.

What does the prefix Anti mean?

antifreeze	A liquid which can be added to water to lower the freezing point and work against it freezing.
antibiotic	A medicine that works against the growth of or destroys microorganisms.
antiseptic	Preventing the growth of disease-carrying microorganisms.

The prefix anti means against or opposite.
