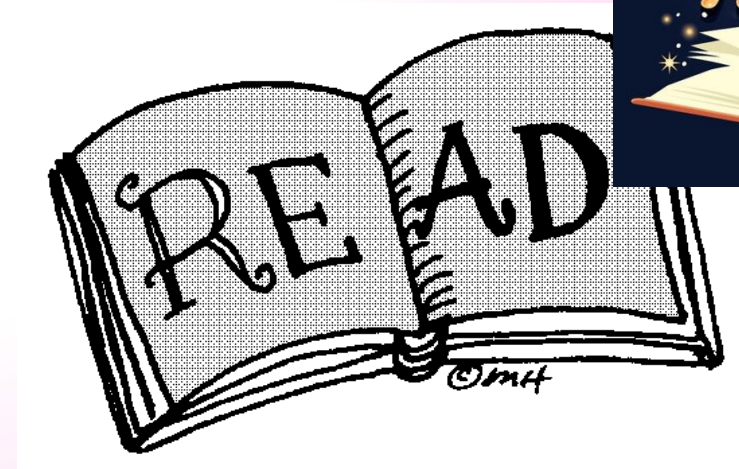
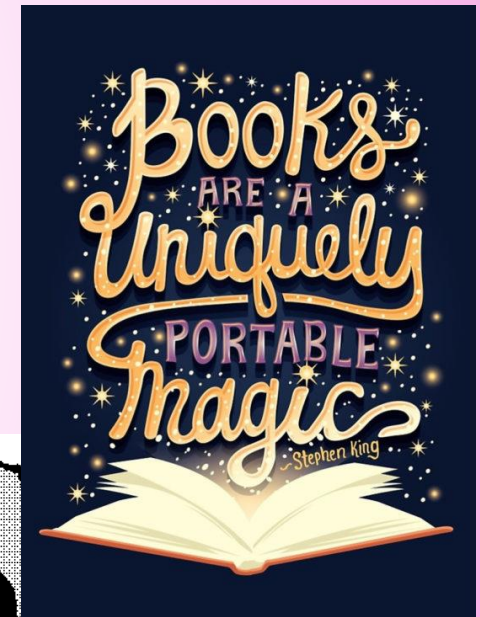
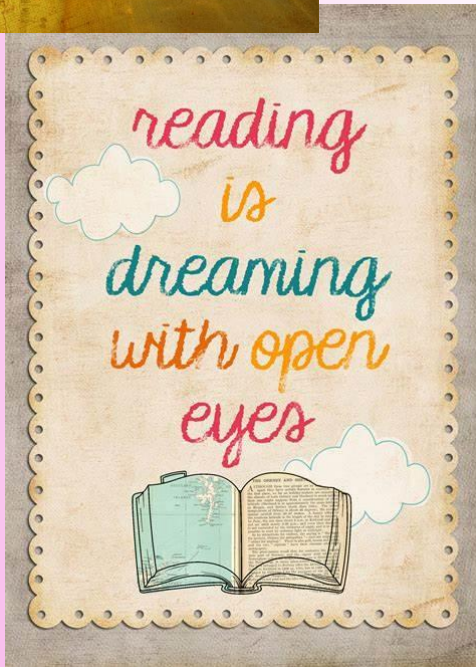


Y3 Reading

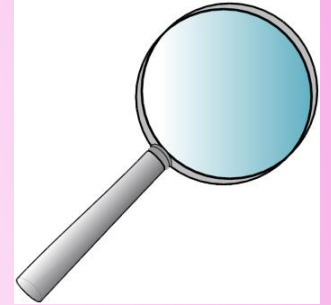


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Today in our reading lesson we are focusing on inference.
