You could write your shape poem on anything.


A shape poem can also be called a concrete poem.



On the following slides there are some shape poems. Read the poems and see if you can work out the shapes.



What is a simile?

A simile is a phrase used to create an effect. It compares something to something else, by using the words like or as.

For example, as shiny as a mirror, as fast as a rocket, as quick as a flash

Or, it was wet like rain, it was cold like ice...

Plan your ideas first, think about -

- ~ What you want to write about.
- ~ Think about key words verbs, adjectives.
- ~ Can you include any similes?
- ~ What shape will it look like?



#### Brainstorming ideas

What does look like? Think of adjectives to describe it and make a list

What does it move like? Think of verbs and ways to describe it. Does it remind you of anything else?

Think about your senses? Does it have a taste? A smell? How does it feel to touch it? How does it make you feel?

#### Brainstorming ideas

Finally, think about the shape on your page. You could write the poem first, and then rewrite it into a shape after.

Or, sketch a line or outline on your page and write the words into it to make your shape poem.

Read through your shape poem and check that all the word choices are appropriate.

Can the adults in your house work out the shape of your poem?
