There are lots of stories about Prophet Muhammad (pbuh). We have already read one story. **What was the title?**



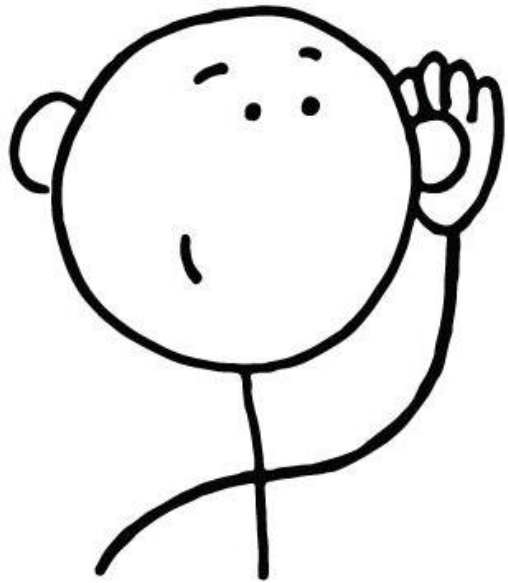
Today you will listen to a couple more stories. **Whilst you are listening to them think of these questions:**

★ Remember: Muslims do not make pictures of their prophets so we don't know what Prophet Muhammad (pbuh) looked like. ★

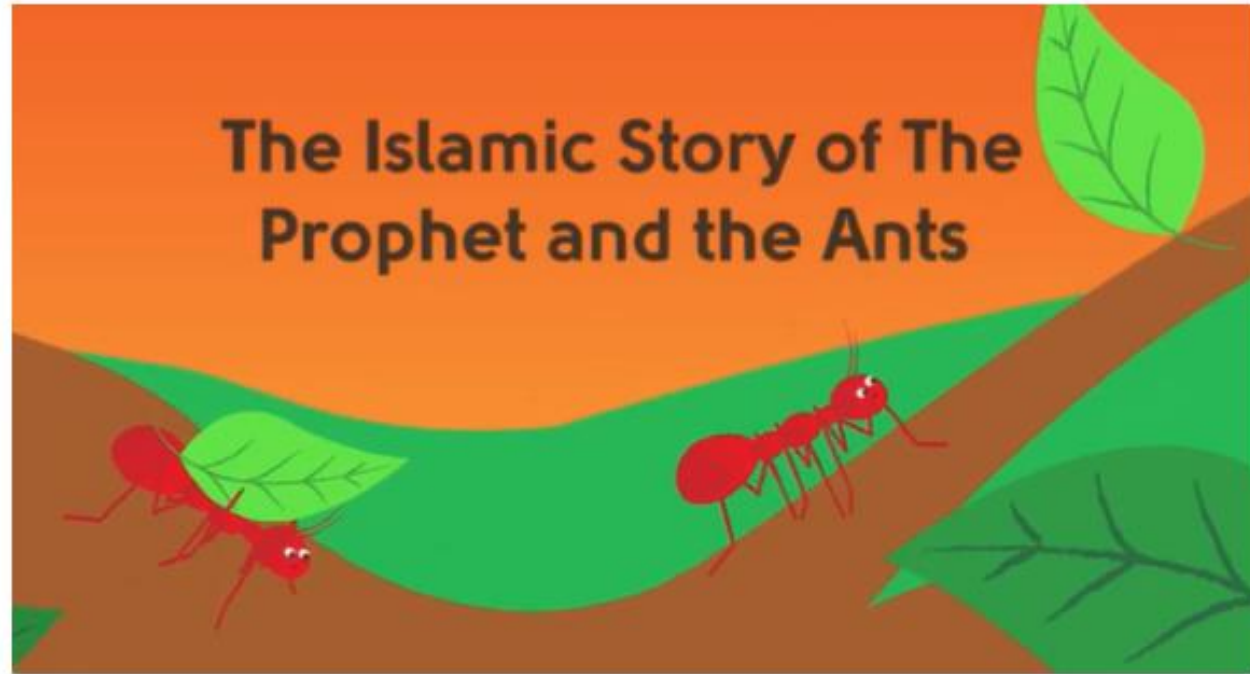

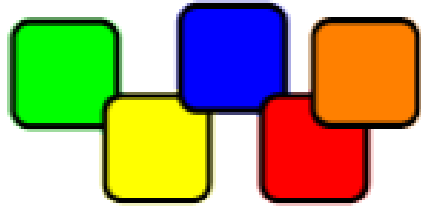
